2026 USA Wrestling National 14U Dual Championships

Enclosed is the schedule and team registration form for the 2026 14U Duals to be held in Wesley Chapel, FL at the Wiregrass Ranch Sports Campus on June 8 - 12. All information and rules regarding this event are available on-line at www.usawrestlingevents.com.

Reminder: Due at Registration - Wednesday, April 1st, 2026

<u>Registration Procedure:</u> It is mandatory for teams to register online at <u>www.usawmembership.com</u> Below is the process:

- 1. Team Registration Form and entry fee (\$1400 per team per style) are due to the host by the stated date April 1st, 2026. States with under 3,000 total members will be afforded the opportunity to submit a \$500 deposit to secure the \$1400 registration per team, per style. Final balance for these particular states must be submitted 10 days prior to the event. Must be submitted online.
- 2. Teams that register after the April 1st deadline will be charged a late fee. The registration fee will increase to \$1,650. After May 14th, the fee will further increase to \$1,900 per team.
- 3. Teams registering after the April 1st deadline are also responsible for providing lodging for their designated state official representative.
- 4. Team Registration Form must include a team leader contact and email address.
- 5. Upon receipt of your Team Entry Form and fee, you will be e-mailed a packet of policies.
- 6. Upon arrival at the event, you will be given your roster for verification. You will need to sign off on team members and seeding points.
- 7. Teams who fail to compete and have paid will be refunded the full amount minus a \$500 noshow fee.

USAW Membership System Directions:

- 1. State Leaders click on your State Leader tab under the Admin section of your profile.
- 2. Click on National Teams and Start a New Team under the 2026 year. Please refer to item 18 on policies and procedures for proper Team Name
- 3. Add a Team Leader to your National Team. This will give them access to add/delete wrestlers to the roster.
- 4. Teams will be seeded according to the aggregate PIN rating for wrestling on participating teams.
- 5. All athletes must have a current membership to be added to a team roster. If the athlete turns 18 during the membership year they will need to complete SafeSport.
- 6. Team Leaders and Coaches must have current Wrestling Leader membership.

Registration: Athlete information should be entered prior to 1:00 PM on June 7, 2026

- 1. Sunday, June 7th at The Wiregrass Ranch Sports Campus at the head table
 - a. Roster verification Greco-Roman: Sunday, June 7 at 6:00 PM
 - b. Roster verification Freestyle (only): Wednesday, June 10 at 4:30
- 2. Teams will be entered and verified through USAWmembership.com.
- 3. All teams participating in the Duals must register at USAWmembership.com.



- 4. Draw numbers for each team will be pulled at the time of roster verification for each event.
- 5. Coaches' Passes: Maximum of four per team.
 - a. Coaches must have a current USA Wrestling Card and a Bronze-Level Coaching Certification (must be presented at registration). Coaches must be entered into the USAW Membership System
 - b. Team Leader Passes: One Team Leader pass will be issued per state. Team Leader must have a current background check and SafeSport completed.
- 6. All State teams must provide one official. Officials must sign up through the USAW Membership System.

Weigh-in/Eligibility:

- 1. Wrestlers able to compete in the 14U National Duals are born 2012 and 2013.
- 2. Weight Classes: 75, 80, 84, 88, 92, 96, 100, 105, 110, 115, 120, 126, 132, 140, 155, 175, & 225.

Mat Official:

- 1. Name of official(s) from your state or \$1000 fee per team/per style.
 - a. Note: Each state association entered in the National Duals must supply a minimum of one mat official for each style in which the state association is competing. If a state association does not provide one mat official per team, a fee of \$1000 will be assessed to each team for each official that is not provided. This fee is due before a team will be allowed to register (Dual Rules available on-line). States need to encourage state officials to sign up through USAWMEMBERSHIP SYSTEM. Registration will begin on February 1st and close on April 1st.

Table Workers:

- 1. Each state association entered in the National Duals is encouraged to supply one **volunteer** for each style in which the state association is competing.
- 2. Volunteers will be asked to either score dual on computer bracketing system or video tape respective teams' duals.
